TO: Connecticut Behavioral Health Partnership (CTBHP) Providers

SUBJECT: Timely Filing Requirements

This bulletin serves to notify all CTBHP providers of a temporary change to the timely filing limit for BHP claims with dates of services October 1, 2007 forward. The filing limit will temporarily be suspended from the first cycle in October through the second cycle in January 2009.

Please note: Timely filing limit for CTBHP claims will revert back to 120 days effective with claims received on February 1, 2009 and forward.

BHP claims for dates of service October 1, 2007 and forward that were previously denied due to failing the 120 day timely filing limit can be re-submitted for processing as long as the claims are processed on or before January 31, 2009.

Timely filing requirements for non-CTBHP claims under Medicaid or the State Administered General Assistance Program will remain unchanged.
