Subject: **ECC Requirements for Medicaid LIA**

Dear Provider,

This bulletin is being sent to Enhanced Care Clinics (ECCs) to clarify any confusion regarding whether ECC requirements apply to Medicaid for Low Income Adults (MLIA, formerly SAGA) members. The Department of Social Services policy transmittal PB10-38, distributed in June 2010 clarified, that as of April 1, 2010, MLIA members have access to the fee-for-service Medicaid health care benefit package. As a result, as of April 1, 2010, ECCs had to meet the ECC requirements for Medicaid LIA members.

Additionally, the CT BHP Behavioral Health Services Flowchart, distributed at the 2/28/11 Provider Forum and posted to the CT BHP website, indicated that service registrations and authorizations would be authorized through the CT BHP in the same manner as existing HUSKY and Charter Oak clients.
